In order to ensure the safety and wellness of the community, the City of Brea continues to diligently monitor the rapidly evolving events related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

To reduce the spread of COVID-19, **all City Facilities are closed for public access**, until further notice. Staff is still available to conduct City business by phone or email. Visit cityofbrea.net/covid19 for a City Service Reference Guide.

City Parks and Trails remain open for the community to responsibly enjoy the outdoors. All other **park amenities are closed**. These include, Playgrounds, Picnic Shelters, Sports Courts, Fitness Equipment, and Skate Parks.

In response to the latest CDC guidelines, **all City events and programs have been postponed or cancelled through May 11**. Cancelled events include, the Pet Expo (4/4), Love Brea (4/25), Public Works/Fire Open House (5/9) and Senior Health and Fitness Day (5/27). Health Hygiene Tips

The community is encouraged to practice good health hygiene and **social distancing** to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and other illnesses.
