- Participant-requested withdrawals must be made at least 3 business days prior to the start of activity and are subject to \$5 processing fee.
- Withdrawals/refunds are NOT available once a program begins.



## **BERRY ST & IMPERIAL HWY INTERSECTION STREET IMPROVEMENTS**

**Start Date:** February 15, 2021

**Anticipated Completion:** Spring 2021

Construct a new right turn lane on Imperial Hwy onto Berry St, as well as some underground work, sidewalk construction, ADA ramps, and signal work.

## **MOORPARK DR WATER IMPROVEMENTS**

**Start Date:** February 22, 2021

**Anticipated Completion:** Spring 2021

Replace approximately 1,250 linear feet of existing ductile iron pipe (DIP) with polyvinyl chloride (PVC) C-900 pipe, along with reconnecting water services and fire hydrants. Located within a residential neighborhood on Moorpark Dr, from Brittany Ln to Larkstone Ln.

## **STREET & WATER IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE NAPOLI TRACT SUBDIVISION**

**Start Date:** March 1, 2021

**Anticipated Completion:** Summer 2021

Replace existing water mains, water service lines, and complete pavement rehabilitation on various streets within the Napoli Tract Subdivision.
