

Report Coyote Sightings & Encounters

Coyote sightings are increasingly common in urban areas, like Brea. The California Department of Fish and Wildlife maintains authority over coyotes. Here are a few helpful tips to prevent human-coyote conflicts:

- NEVER feed coyotes/wildlife and remove sources of food and water
- If followed by a coyote, make loud noises, never run
- Do not leave small pets unattended
- Trim ground-level shrubbery to reduce hiding places
