

The City of Brea recently converted to a new meeting agenda management system. This new, streamlined system makes accessing the latest agendas for City Council meetings, including all Commission and Committee meetings, transparently with ease. To access this feature, simply click on the "Agendas & Minutes" button, from the homepage of the City's website, and select which meeting you would like to view. From there, click through and view or download reports and attachments in one centralized location. The site can be viewed on any platform, from a desktop computer, tablet or mobile device. To view a past City Council meeting, the interactive meeting agenda allows you to jump to specific meeting items providing a more streamlined experience for viewing.

Love Brea is a great opportunity to take part in a meaningful day to serve our community. Brea joins a long list of cities participating in this regional day of community service. Since 2015, thousands of community volunteers have completed hundreds of service projects to help make a meaningful impact in Brea. Since the start of Love Brea there has been over 200 projects, more than 2,500 volunteers, greater than 25 community partners, and about \$62,000 donated.

This year, Love Brea will take place on Saturday, April 27. Service projects tend to range from mulching The Tracks at Brea trail to helping those in need with home renovations.



A family-friendly event, project opportunities for Love Brea tend to be varied and suited for group working styles, as well as individual-based activities. Project submissions will begin on February 23. If you would like to participate and contribute to your community, volunteers can sign-up for a project starting March 22.

Brea Mall Redevelopment Project Update

The Simon Brea Mall Redevelopment Project has begun construction. In 2023, the City approved Planning entitlements for the demolition of the former Sears building to make way for a redeveloped space that will feature 119,000 square feet for shoppers to explore world-class brands and new restaurant concepts. The Brea Mall has announced the following new stores and restaurants – Zara, Pacific Catch, Din Tai Fung, Dick’s Sporting Goods, Philz Coffee, and the Melt, with many more to come. In addition, a 90,000 square foot Lifetime Fitness and a 380-unit apartment building are also components of the project.

Construction-wise, the project has recently been issued demolition and underground utility permits. That has resulted in the full demolition of the former Sears structure and utility groundwork that is currently being performed. This work will continue over the course of the winter months before vertical construction is anticipated to begin later in 2024, weather permitting. In an effort to minimize impacts to traffic, residents, utilities, and businesses, some construction work is anticipated to occur during nighttime hours. ALIGN SPINE CENTER

721 E. Imperial Highway



With Planning Commission’s recent approval in December 2023, the existing one-story, 3,580 square-foot building at 721 East Imperial Highway will soon be transformed into a two-story, 8,723 square-foot state-of-the-art medical facility, with a brand-new exterior façade. Once completed, the newly-renovated building will be occupied by Align Spine Center, which is an outpatient orthopedic, spine, and pain musculoskeletal health care practice that is currently located in the City of Fullerton. The construction is expected to begin in Summer/Fall 2024.

SMART PARKE

835 E. Birch Street, Suite 07

In September 2023, the Planning Commission approved a conditional use permit for Smart Parke to be located at 835 E. Birch Street, which

is a tenant space within the Brea Marketplace Shopping Center that was previously occupied by Golf Galaxy. Smart Parke is a modern daycare and an overnight boarding facility for family pets, offering a variety of animal services for dogs and cats (i.e. daycare, overnight boarding, and ancillary training services) and retail sale of related pet products. Smart Parke is anticipated to open its doors in Spring/Summer 2024.

Go Green & Spring Clean!

The City of Brea wants to help you decide which items go in which bin while you spring clean this season. Below are some tips from our Recycle Brea division.

Items that can go in your curbside green recycle cart include:

- Paper, such as cardboard, magazines, newspapers. Plastic like bottles and jugs. Metal, such as aluminum and tin cans. And glass bottles and jars.
- Make sure these items are empty, clean, and dry. Remember that plastic bags **CANNOT** be recycled and should be disposed of in your black landfill cart.

When clearing out clutter, consider repurposing or donating items.

- Reach out to family, friends, neighbors, and the surrounding community to see if anyone is interested in taking in those items.

Cut down on single-use cleaning supplies, like paper towels and disposable mopping pads, by swapping them with old towels/rags and using your favorite household cleaner. Once done cleaning, wash and reuse them for future deep cleans.

Household items that **CANNOT** go in your curbside carts: light bulbs, batteries, electronics, paint, chemicals/cleaners.

- Make sure to safely dispose of these hazardous items at the nearest Hazardous Waste Collection Center located in Anaheim (1071 N. Blue Gum Street – 9:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.).

Take advantage of the free services provided to you by Republic Services. Brea residents are allowed three (3) bulky item pick-ups per year with 20 items per collection. To schedule a bulky item or e-waste pickup, call Republic Services at 714-238-2444.

Brea Fire Department Offers CERT Training

The Community Emergency Response Team, better known as CERT, is a nationwide program that trains citizen responders to help in their neighborhood in the event of a large-scale disaster or other local emergency. Participants receive classroom and hands-on training to learn about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact neighborhoods. Basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations are also taught. CERT training is provided free of charge, but pre-registration is required for each class. Registration is open to those residing in Brea. 




It's Golf Season in Brea


