**SUBJECT:** Public Hearing to Receive Input from the Community Regarding the Proposed Transition to By-District City Council Elections; Selection of a District Map and Election Sequence; and Introduction of Ordinance No. 1225, Establishing a By-District System for City Council Elections

---

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council do the following in connection with the proposed transition to a by-district election system:

1. Conduct a public hearing to receive public input regarding selection of a district map and the sequence of district elections.
2. Approve a motion to select a district map.
3. Approve a motion to determine the sequence of district elections.
4. Approve a motion to introduce Ordinance No. 1225, adding Chapter 2.32 (City Council Districts) to the Brea City Code and making a CEQA exemption determination, by title only and waive further reading.

**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

The City of Brea currently uses an “at-large” election system, in which all voters in the City have the opportunity to vote for candidates for all five (5) seats on the City Council. City Council candidates may reside anywhere in the City, and they each provide citywide representation. A by-district election system is one in which the City is physically divided into voting districts, each with one (1) council member who resides in the district and is chosen by the electors residing in that particular district.

On May 6, 2019, the City of Brea received a notice letter from Shenkman & Hughes, P.C. (“S&H”) alleging that the City’s at-large election system violates the California Voting Rights Act (“CVRA”). The City and S&H subsequently executed an Extension Agreement, in which S&H agreed to refrain from filing a CVRA action as long as the City took specified steps to transition to by-district elections. In accordance with the Extension Agreement, on June 20, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2019-049, declaring its intent to transition from at-large elections to by-district elections for City Council.

Pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-049, the City Council intends to consider adoption of an ordinance to transition to by-district elections in accordance with applicable laws, including Government Code Section 34886 and Elections Code Section 10010. Resolution No. 2019-049 directed staff to work with the City Clerk, City Attorney, a demographer, and other appropriate consultants as needed, to provide a detailed analysis of the City’s current demographics and any other information or data necessary to prepare a draft map that divides the City into voting districts in a manner consistent with the intent and purpose of the CVRA and the Federal Voting Rights Act (“FVRA”). After conducting a Request for Proposals, on July 20, 2021, the City Council approved a Professional Services Agreement with National Demographics Corporation (“NDC”) for Electoral Districting Services. NDC has provided the City with results from the 2020 United States Census, as well as other City

demographics, which provide critical information needed to create voting districts. To transition to by-district elections, the City is required to conduct four (4) public hearings before the final map adoption, which would be due to the Orange County Registrar of Voters by April 17, 2022:

- At least two (2) public hearings before maps are drawn, within a 30-day period
- At least two (2) public hearings after maps are drawn, within a 45-day period
- Ordinance introduction to establish by-district elections and adopt map
- Ordinance adoption at a regular or adjourned regular meeting

In addition to considering public input received during the public hearings, the City must ensure compliance with the following rank-ordered, state-and federally-mandated criteria in the following order of priority:

**Federal Criteria for Cities:**

1. Each council district shall contain a nearly equal population as required by law; and
2. Each council district shall be drawn in a manner that complies with the FVRA. No council district shall be drawn with race as the predominant factor in violation of the principles established by the United States Supreme Court in *Shaw v. Reno*, 509 U.S. 630 (1993), and its progeny.

**California Criteria for Cities:**

1. Geographically contiguous
2. Undivided neighborhoods and “communities of interest” (socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)
3. Easily identifiable boundaries
4. Compact (do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

**Other Traditional Districting Principles:**

1. Respect voters’ choices / continuity in office
2. Future population growth

### Public Hearings #1 & #2

The City Council held pre-draft map public hearings on September 27, 2021 and October 27, 2021 to receive public input regarding the composition of the district maps and any potential communities of interest. At Public Hearing #2, NDC provided paper map kits and demonstrated how to use online mapping tools available for the community to use to indicate how they think the district lines should be drawn. Maps received from members of the public were collected and provided to City Council for consideration at Public Hearing #3.

### First District Mapping Workshop

On January 12, 2022, the City and NDC hosted its first District Mapping Workshop, both in person at

the Brea Community Center and on Zoom. The purpose of this workshop was to gather additional public feedback on how the districts should look and to provide further education to residents on how to draw and submit their own draft voting district maps using the various mapping tools.

The deadline for members of the public to submit their maps for consideration at Public Hearing #3 was January 21, 2022. This deadline was necessary to comply with state law, which requires that all draft voting district maps are to be posted at least seven (7) days in advance of Council consideration at a public hearing.

### **Public Hearing #3**

Prior to Public Hearing #3, staff received a total of seventeen (17) draft voting district maps for Council consideration. Of that total, fourteen (14) maps were received from members of the public and three (3) maps and suggested sequences of elections were prepared by NDC. NDC indicated that three (3) of the fourteen (14) maps from the public — Map 110, Map 111, and Map 114 — did not meet the legally-mandated criteria, and NDC noted the defect(s) on the respective submissions.

On February 1, 2022, the City Council held Public Hearing #3 and received a report from NDC related to the draft maps and suggested election sequencing. After receiving public testimony, the City Council selected five (5) focus maps: Map 103, Map 108, Map 115, Map 116 and Map 117. In addition, Council directed NDC to make specific outlined changes to Map 106 and bring the modified Map 106 back to the next public hearing for deliberation.

During the hearing, staff reported that three (3) draft maps were received from the same member of the public prior to Public Hearing #3, but after the submission deadline. As such, these three (3) draft maps were not permitted to be considered by the Council at Public Hearing #3. Staff indicated that these three (3) draft maps and the modified Map 106 would be brought back to the next public hearing.

### **Second District Mapping Workshop**

On February 12, the City held its second District Mapping Workshop both in person at the Brea Community Center and on Zoom. This workshop was held on a Saturday to accommodate members of the community who may not have the opportunity to participate during the week. During the workshop, Dr. Justin Levitt from NDC presented an overview of the districting process to date, as well as the focus maps that the City Council is considering. The large focus maps were available for the public to view in detail, and materials were provided for community members to make comments on specific areas of the maps. This workshop also gave community members an opportunity to ask questions and discuss the maps collectively. The public feedback collected at this workshop is provided as an attachment to the staff report.

### **Public Hearing #4**

The map submission deadline for consideration at this public hearing was February 14, 2022. Four (4) additional draft maps were published on the City's website in accordance with legal requirements in advance of this public hearing. These maps included the three (3) previously mentioned public maps, which were received after the first map submission deadline: Map 119, Map 120 and Map 121; along with the modified Map 106, which is now referred to as Map 118. No other maps from the public were received.

In addition to outlining the proposed voting districts, each of the maps also identifies NDC's suggested election sequencing. In accordance with legal requirements, there must be three (3) districts up for election in 2022 and two (2) districts up for election in 2024.

During Public Hearing #4 on February 23, the City Council received public testimony and discussed

the additional four (4) draft maps, along with the five (5) focus maps selected at the previous public hearing. After deliberation, the City Council selected two (2) new focus maps, Map 117 and 118, to continue considering at the next public hearing; and directed staff to continue community outreach to gauge the public's thoughts on the transition to by-district elections and which of the two (2) focus maps they prefer.

## **Public Hearing #5**

During Public Hearing #5, the City Council will continue to receive public testimony and discuss the final two (2) focus maps, Maps 117 and 118. After deliberation the City Council may select a voting district map and election sequence for adoption. Once the map and sequence have been selected, the City Council may consider the introduction of Ordinance No. 1225 to change to a by-district election system, adopt the selected voting district map, and set the election sequence.

## **Community Outreach**

To engage the community in the districting process, staff have conducted a full marketing campaign since September 2021. These efforts include the following:

- Publication of notices translated in Spanish and Korean in *The Star Progress*, *Excelsior California*, and *The Korea Daily* prior to each public hearing
- Creation of a dedicated webpage: [cityofbrea.net/districting](http://cityofbrea.net/districting)
- Promotion of articles on Districting as the "Top Story" on the City's website
- Mailing of postcards to every residence in Brea outlining the project's timeline and opportunities to get involved
- Display of large promotional posters at six (6) bus shelters strategically-located throughout the City for three (3) months (totaling 521,301 average target in-market impressions)
- Display of large promotional posters at four (4) large kiosks in Downtown Brea
- Creation of a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) answering nineteen (19) key questions for the community
- Posting of print signage posted at three (3) City facilities: Civic & Cultural Center; Community Center; and Senior Center
- Announcements at City Council, Commission, and Committee Meetings
- Mailing of over 11, 330 Promotional Flyers with Water Bill Statements
- Distribution of Informational Letter to Brea businesses
- E-mail sent to 143 key Community Group Leaders & Stakeholders
- Addition of informational articles to various newsletters, including as the cover of the two most recent Brea Line Newsletters (Mailed to 20,267 residences)
- Addition of many featured articles to monthly Brea Online Newsletters (1,093 subscribers)
- Addition of articles in the City Manager's Reports (407 recipients)
- Promotion on Brea TV/the City's Cable Channel
- Information table at Taste of Brea event on October 7, 2021
- Held two District Mapping Workshops both online and on Zoom
- Social media posts across various platforms, including:
  - Facebook (ranging from 232-1,128 impressions\* per post),
  - Twitter (ranging from 374-845 impressions\* per post)
  - Instagram (ranging from 220-2,595 impressions\* per post), and
  - Nextdoor (ranging from 661-805 impressions\* per post)

\*Impressions are defined as the number of times content has been seen

At Public Hearing #4, the City Council directed staff to conduct additional community outreach and engagement to highlight the final two (2) focus maps (Map 117 and 118), and to gauge the public's thoughts on the transition to by-district elections. As part of these efforts and per City Council's direction, staff created an Electronic Feedback Form which was posted on the City's website on March 1 and remained available through March 20. Staff conducted the following outreach to promote

the Electronic Feedback Form:

- Staff presentation at the Senior Center to over 100 participants on February 25, 2022 and distributed printed hard-copy Feedback Forms
- Information table at Movie's Under the Stars at the Civic & Cultural Center on March 12, 2022
- Direct mailers to 628 businesses, residents and property owners in the overlap areas between Maps 117 and 118
- E-mail letter sent to 5,899 businesses
- E-mail sent to Brea Olinda Unified School District (BOUSD) families on behalf of the City
- Additional e-mail sent to 143 key Community Group Leaders & Stakeholders
- QR Codes and printed Feedback Forms displayed at the Brea Community Center, as well as during the Spring Craft Boutique
- Informational video created and posted on the City's website and played on-loop on Brea TV every half-hour and on social media platforms
- Social media posts across various platforms, including:
  - Facebook (305 impressions per post),
  - Twitter (302 impressions per post)
  - Instagram (549 impressions per post), and
  - Nextdoor (355 impressions per post)

### **Electronic Feedback Form Results**

On March 1, 2022, staff published an Electronic Feedback Form on the City's website and began a public outreach campaign aimed at engaging the community by receiving direct feedback via the online form. The Electronic Feedback Form asked three (3) questions related to the final two (2) focus maps, Maps 117 and 118, as well as how by-district elections will impact the community overall. Staff received a total of 145 responses to the Electronic Feedback Form as of Thursday, March 17. The full list of responses received are attached.

As of March 17, 2022, a summary of survey feedback is outlined below:

Results from Questions 1 and 2:

- 141 respondents answered question one, "Which map do you prefer?". Of the 141 responses, 67 individuals indicated that they preferred focus Map 117. When asked in question two, "How would your neighborhood benefit from either map?", these respondents indicated that Map 117 contains easier-to-identify boundaries such as the 57 freeway; keeps neighborhoods intact; allows for better representation; is more simplified; is more compact; and keeps the community more cohesive.
- 31 respondents indicated they preferred focus Map 118, as it better balances potential economic disparities between residential areas; splits the commercial/retail areas more evenly between districts; and keeps neighborhoods intact.
- 22 respondents indicated that neither map is preferred.
- 21 respondents selected the option that either map would be preferred.

Results from Question 3:

The final question on the Electronic Feedback Form asked, "Overall, how do you think by-district elections will impact you?". Staff received a variety of responses to this question, including those who indicated they feel districting will have negative, positive, minimal, unknown, or no impacts. Several respondents commented on the impact of by-district elections on the number of votes they will have in City Council elections, while others felt transitioning to by-district elections will result in better representation. The full responses can be found in the attached "Electronic Feedback Form Results."

## **Next Steps**

At this time, staff is recommending the City Council select its preferred map, designate district election sequence, and introduce Ordinance No. 1225.





I live in Brea on \_\_\_\_\_ I would like to provide my preference for the new maps. I believe that out of the two, Map 118 (modified 106) would demonstrate more diversity for the different districts, resulting in a more fair election process.







**ORDINANCE NO. 1225**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BREA ESTABLISHING A BY-DISTRICT SYSTEM FOR CITY COUNCIL ELECTIONS, AMENDING THE BREA CITY CODE, AND MAKING A DETERMINATION OF EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BREA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**A. RECITALS:**

(i) On May 6, 2019, the City received a claim alleging that the City's at-large election system violates the California Voting Rights Act (Elections Code Section 14025 et seq.).

(ii) On June 20, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution 2019-049 declaring its intent to transition from at-large elections for City Council to by-district elections for City Council after receipt of the 2020 Census results.

(iii) Upon receipt of the 2020 Census results, in accordance with Elections Code Section 10010, the City held two public hearings before the drawing of potential voting district maps (on September 27, 2021 and October 27, 2021) and two public hearings after the drawing of potential voting district maps (on February 1, 2022, and February 23, 2022).

(iv) The City exceeded state law requirements by also holding two district mapping workshops (on January 12, 2022 and February 12, 2022).

(v) The Council District Map set forth in the attached Exhibit A is compliant with the criteria specified in Elections Code Section 21601.

(vi) This Ordinance's change in the method of electing City Council Members is being made in furtherance of the purposes of the California Voting Rights Act.

**B. ORDINANCE:**

**SECTION 1. Code Amendment.** Title 2 (Administration and Personnel) of the Brea City

Code is amended by adding a new Chapter 2.32 to read as follows:

**“CHAPTER 2.32: CITY COUNCIL DISTRICTS**

<b>2.32.010</b>	<b>Voting Districts Established.</b>
<b>2.32.020</b>	<b>Election of City Council Members by District.</b>
<b>2.32.030</b>	<b>Commencement of District Elections.</b>
<b>2.32.040</b>	<b>Redistricting.</b>

**§ 2.32.010 VOTING DISTRICTS ESTABLISHED.** Five City Council voting districts are established in the City of Brea. The boundaries and identifying number of each voting district shall be as described on the official “Council District Map” on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

**§ 2.32.020 ELECTION OF CITY COUNCILMEMBERS BY DISTRICT.**

A. City Council Members shall be elected “by district” as defined in Government Code Section 34871. A person shall not be eligible to be elected to hold office as a City Council Member unless he or she satisfies all of the following criteria: (i) is otherwise qualified as required by law; (ii) resides in the geographical area making up the voting district from which he or she is nominated to be elected; and (iii) is a registered voter of the City at the time nomination papers are issued to him or her as provided in Elections Code Section 10227.

B. Registered voters signing nomination papers or voting for a City Council candidate shall be residents of the geographical area making up the voting district from which the City Council Member is to be elected.

**§ 2.32.030 COMMENCEMENT OF DISTRICT ELECTIONS.**

A. Commencing with the general municipal election in November 2022, the voters in Council District Nos. [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] shall elect City Council Members by district for full four year terms.

B. Commencing with the general municipal election in November 2024, the voters in Council District Nos. \_\_\_ and \_\_\_ shall elect City Council Members by district for full four year terms.

C. No City Council Member term of office that commenced prior to the effective date of this Chapter shall be affected.

**§ 2.32.040 REDISTRICTING.**

The City Council shall adjust the boundaries of the City Council voting districts based on annexations and decennial federal census results in accordance with Elections Code Section 21601 et seq.”

**SECTION 2. Map Adoption.** The Official Council District Map set forth in the attached Exhibit A is adopted and incorporated herein by reference. The Official Council District Map shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

**SECTION 3. Technical Adjustments.** If necessary to facilitate the implementation of this Ordinance, the City Manager is authorized to make technical adjustments to the Official Council District Map that do not substantively affect the populations in the voting districts, the eligibility of candidates, or the residence of elected officials within any voting district. The City Manager shall consult with the City Attorney concerning any technical adjustments deemed necessary and shall advise the City Council of any such adjustments required for the implementation of the voting districts.

CEQA.** The City Council finds that adoption of this Ordinance is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”) review because it is not a “project” pursuant to Title 14, Section 15378(b) of the California Code of Regulations. The Council further finds that adoption of this Ordinance is exempt from CEQA review pursuant to Title 14, Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Code of Regulations because it can be seen with certainty that this Ordinance will not have any potentially significant adverse impact on the environment.

**SECTION 5. Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall nonetheless remain in full force and effect. The City Council declares that it would have adopted each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unenforceable.

**SECTION 6. Certification.** The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance.
