ACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR YOUR CURBSIDE RECYCLE CART INCLUDE:

- ✓ **ALUMINUM/METAL**
Beverage cans, Food cans
- ✓ **PLASTIC**
Bottles, Cups, Containers, Jugs
- ✓ **PAPER**
Newspaper, Envelopes, Junk mail, Phone books,
Brochures, Magazines
- ✓ **CARDBOARD**
Ream wrappers, File folders, Poster board,
Frozen food boxes, Cardboard boxes, Milk cartons
- ✓ **GLASS**
Beverage containers, Food jars

SOME ITEMS CANNOT GO IN YOUR CURBSIDE CARTS

Light bulbs, batteries, electronics, paint, chemicals/cleaners.

Make sure to safely dispose of these hazardous items at the nearest Hazardous Waste Collection Center in Anaheim (1071 N. Blue Gum Street) Open Tuesday - Saturday, 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.



CONSIDER REPURPOSING OR DONATING ITEMS

Reach out to your family, friends, neighbors, and the surrounding community to see if they are interested in taking the items that are no longer of use to you.

CUT DOWN ON SINGLE-USE CLEANING SUPPLIES

Cut down on single-use cleaning supplies, like paper towels and disposable mopping pads, by swapping them with old towels/rags and using your favorite household cleaner. Once done cleaning, wash and reuse them for future deep cleans!



TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE FREE SERVICES PROVIDED TO YOU
