A Forum for Marginalized Voices

Call for Advisory Board Members

The Curtis Theatre is seeking nominations to the **Amplify Advisory Board**. The ideal candidate is an artist or arts advocate who is passionate about increasing their community's involvement in the performing arts, addressing inequality, and amplifying the voices of marginalized artists.

The Advisory Board will meet twice to review artist submissions, discuss representation in Orange County performing arts, and select works to be featured in the Curtis Theatre season. They will also serve as ambassadors for the program– connecting with artists in their communities who may be interested in participating in *Amplify*, and encouraging submission of their artistic works for consideration.

For the sake of equity and representation, diversity within the board is as important as diversity among artists chosen to perform. People of all backgrounds, including (but not limited to) Black, Indigenous, People of Color, Asian-American and Pacific Islanders, Pan-Ethnic, Women, Persons with Disabilities, and LGBTQIA+ communities are encouraged to participate both as artists and Advisory Board members.

Participation on the Amplify Advisory Board is a volunteer position, but Curtis Theatre staff will make every effort to keep the time commitment to a minimum. Board members will also receive recognition in the Season Brochure and be eligible for complimentary tickets to all Curtis Theatre season performances.
