- What is Amplify?
 - Amplify is an initiative to address inequality in performing arts programming. This program aims to provide a platform and outlet for performing artists of all kinds while broadening the Curtis Theatre's inclusivity and outreach to a diverse artistic community.
- Who should apply to be a part of Amplify?
 - Because inequality within the performing arts is not reserved for any one group, the Amplify initiative embraces diversity of all kinds. Artists of all backgrounds, including (but not limited to) Black, Indigenous, People of Color, Asian-American and Pacific Islanders, Pan-Ethnic, Women, Persons with Disabilities, and LGBTQIA+ communities are encouraged to participate.
- How do you apply to be an Amplify artist?

- When and where do performances take place?
 - Performances take place at the City of Brea’s Curtis Theatre. Chosen artists will be offered a performance day as part of the Curtis Theatre’s season.
- What do Amplify artists get?
 - As part of the Curtis Theatre’s season lineup, artists receive the full support of the Curtis administrative and technical team, including audio and lighting capabilities, advertising, rehearsal space, and box office support. Each artist is also granted a \$1,500 honorarium.
