Custom *Walk of Honor* pavers are designed as a lasting tribute to the men and women who have served our country and are an integral part of the Brea Veterans Memorial. The Veterans Memorial was dedicated in November, 2012, and is located in front of the Brea Civic & Cultural Center. Personalized stone pavers can be ordered anytime until sold out and make a unique gift for the active, retired or veteran in your family.

A commemorative certificate suitable for gift giving is provided following your order. All pavers ordered each year, will be inscribed in the *Walk of Honor* once a year and unveiled on Veterans Day.


Three paver options are available:



Brea Veterans Memorial Walk of Honor Guidelines

To preserve the sanctity of the Brea War Memorial, the artist's design, and the significance of the Walk of Honor, the following guidelines have been established:

1. Walk of Honor pavers are designed to honor veterans and active/retired military personnel only.
2. Brea residency is NOT required.
3. A commemorative certificate is be issued as proof of purchase and gift giving.
4. Pavers will be inscribed collectively once per year for Veterans Day. Annual deadline: August 31.
5. The paver inscriptions must follow the following format of military information; no additional information is allowed:
Line 1: Name
Line 2: Rank
Line 3: Branch of Military Service (Limited to the five main branches) Line 4: Conflict (Can be left blank if served during peacetime)
6. No additional military information may be added. Only official names and rank may be used, no colloquialisms are permitted.
7. No commercial or personal messages are allowed.
8. 100% of proceeds raised from paver sales are expressly earmarked for memorial maintenance only.
9. Placement of pavers is at the discretion of the City.

Seeking Nominations for the Wall of Remembrance Killed in Action – Brea's Own

The Brea Memorial also includes the Wall of Remembrance where names of Brea's fallen heroes are inscribed. Do you know someone who may be eligible? So far, the names of 19 Breans have been added to the black granite anchoring the memorial site. Please help us ensure that all eligible Breans are included.

Honorees must meet the established criteria, which includes having lived in Brea; and were killed while on active duty during wartime, on foreign soil, or during training from World War I to the present day.
