- Grass & Leaves (loose, not bagged unless using a compostable bag)
- Prunings & Weeds
- Twigs & Small Branches
- (4 inches or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in length)
- Vegetation (from the yard)

### NO

- Animal & Food Waste
- Construction Debris
- Dirt & Rocks
- Palm Fronds
- Plastic Bags, unless compostable
- Rugs, Flooring & Metal
- Recyclables & Trash
- Hazardous Waste\*

## Residential Bulky Item Collection

To aid residents with the disposal of large bulky household items such as; furniture, stoves and water heaters, Republic Services provides FREE\* on-call bulky item pick up collection. These special collections are provided by appointment only. Please be prepared to list the items you would like to have picked up. (\*Limit three per calendar year.)
