



INDUSTRIAL GENERAL PERMIT COVERAGE & ELIGIBLE BUSINESS ACTIVITIES IN THE CITY OF BREA

INDUSTRIAL GENERAL PERMIT COVERAGE

The State of California requires industrial facilities that conduct certain activities to be covered by an Industrial General Permit from the State Water Resource Control Board. Industrial activities include manufacturing, hazardous waste and recycling storage and disposal facilities, and large-scale processing. Eligibility is determined by the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code, as identified by the business owner. Specific permit requirements are based on the runoff potential of the site, which varies based on where activities are conducted and if runoff can leave the site.

NEW REQUIREMENTS AFFECTING ALL BUSINESSES IN THE CITY OF BREA

Beginning January 1, 2020, the State requires that new business licenses and renewals that use a regulated SIC code must provide a WDID number showing coverage under the Industrial Permit Program. All business license applications and renewals require a self-identified SIC Code.

IF YOUR BUSINESS USES ONE OF THE FOLLOWING SIC CODES, YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COVERAGE UNDER THE INDUSTRIAL GENERAL PERMIT:

- ▶ 10xx-14xx (Oil and Gas Mining Facilities)
- ▶ 20xx-39xx (Manufacturing Facilities)
- ▶ 40xx-45xx (Transportation Facilities)
- ▶ 4211-4225 (Storage Facilities)
- ▶ 5015/5093 (Recycling Facilities)
- ▶ 5171 (Petroleum Bulk Stations)

BUSINESS LICENSE APPROVALS IN THE CITY

In order to process your business license please verify that your SIC code is correct and matches the activity conducted at your facility. If it does, you must contact the State Water Board and obtain permit coverage or an exemption. You will not be issued a business license by the City until your WDID is received. If you do not obtain coverage, your business license will be rescinded.
